When Meeting Online

1. Get to know them first

Meeting on video call is great. Then you can see surroundings and when you get to know when better maybe ask them to see a little more of their surroundings. Eventually they may want you to meet their friends and meet family online.

2. Keep your contact information safe

1. Meet in a public place

This can be a bar or a restaurant. Make sure it is somewhere not too remote and fairly busy. We suggest drinks to start so that you are not tied into a meal in case you want to leave

2. Make sure you know the full name of the person you are meeting.

Some people may not want to disclose full names, but it is worth asking and letting them know you just ask people their full name to stay safe on a first date.

3. Grab a screenshot of their picture with contact details. Send to a friend or family member who will be around and checking their phone when you are on your date.

3. Let friends know where you are going and who you are meeting

Tell at least one person where you are going and who you are meeting.

4. Have transport booked from the venue

You can always postpone if you want to leave later, but having a taxi or other transport booked can help. Or drive and have your car close by. Let them know when you arrive there is a time limit to leave. You can always extend it afterwards. 5. Switch the Find My Friends app on

6. Drop a pin
